

## Davos Congress Centre - Rooms

Davos is known worldwide for the annual World Economic Forum (WEF) with over 3,000 participants including world leaders in politics and business. The much-cited "Spirit of Davos" is by no means a ghost. On the contrary, it is one of the reasons for Davos' success as a congress town. At 1,560 m above sea level, nature is the main protagonist despite the urban infrastructure. Please take the entrance from the street "**Promenade**" to the **House C** of the Davos Congress Centre to all conference rooms:

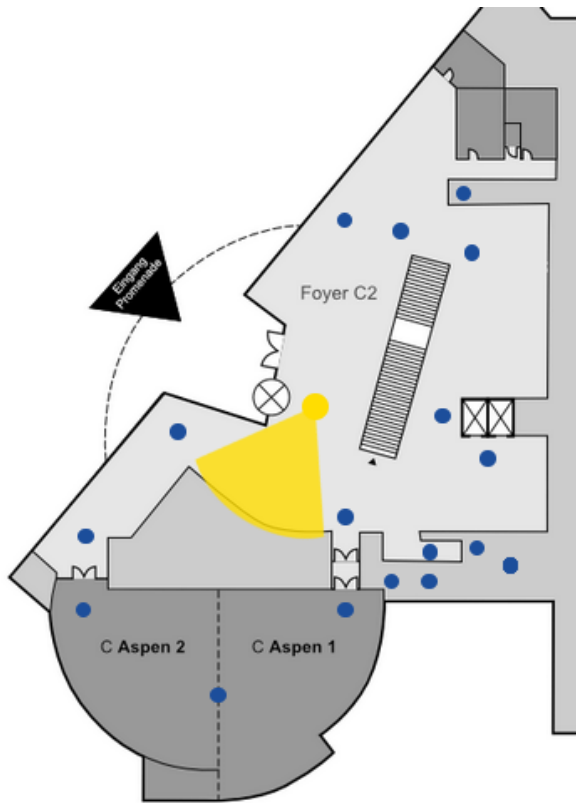

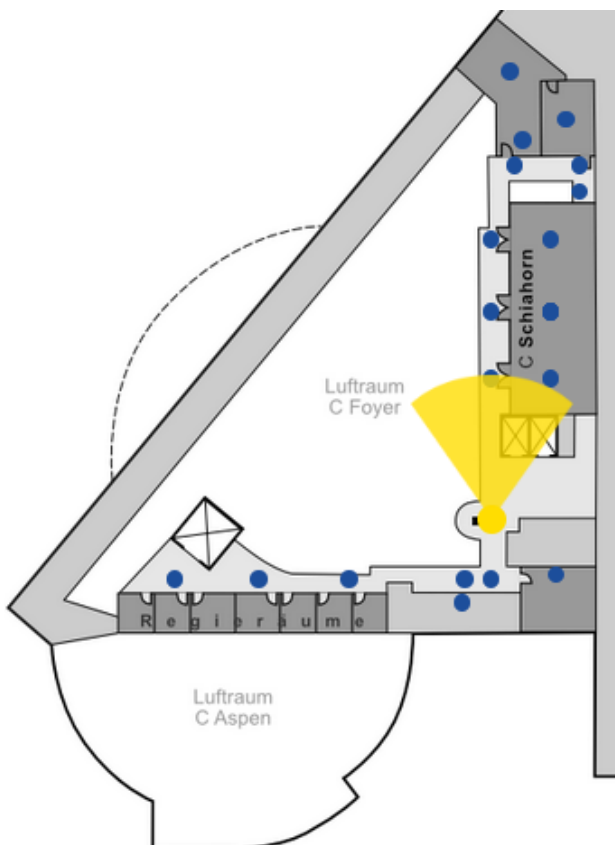


[Virtual tour](#) 4<sup>th</sup> upper floor (Aspen, Schiahorn)
