

## Getting to Davos

### Getting to Davos by car

Davos is located in eastern Switzerland in the heart of Graubünden. If you are travelling by car, take the motorway in the direction of Chur and take the Landquart exit in the direction of Davos. In winter, snow chains may be necessary from Klosters in the event of heavy snowfall (except for four-wheel drive vehicles). Various charging stations are available for electric vehicles.

### Motorways Switzerland

From Zurich, take the A3/A13 motorway (follow the green signs) in the direction of Chur as far as Landquart. From Landquart continue on the cantonal road 28 to Davos Klosters. Please note that you need a motorway toll sticker (CHF 40.-) for the motorways in Switzerland. This is available at all border crossings, petrol stations and post offices.
